
Mark's rig begins with threading the **Avid Flying Chod Bead components** on to the mainline.



Pull the bead securely over the buffer at the desired distance from the lead.



Then thread on the chod rig. The modern readymade versions are as good as any.



Finally, thread on the second bead and set it to give the hooklink the desired amount of 'travel'.
